

Troop 359 Instructions for Collecting Town Redeemable

The redeemable dumpster is the first one on your left as you drive in (below the area where trash and recyclables are dropped off). Drive around to the top by the trash dumpster, get the key to the dumpster from one of the employees, and drive back around to the dumpster. The end of the dumpster opens. Inside are supplies - cardboard boxes for bottles, bags for cans and plastics, latex gloves.

Take empty boxes out of the dumpster to put bottles into (approx. 15-20 per week is typically what is needed) and drive back up to the table above. Load all bottles into boxes (24 per box for \$1.20 total) and toss plastics and cans down into the dumpster below. Completely clear off the table and discard of all trash. Load boxes of bottles into your vehicle. It's important to take the bottles first because this is the area that the town wants cleaned up completely on a weekly basis.

Next, drive back down to the dumpster. Fill plastic bags with 200 cans per bag (beer & soda together - \$10 per bag), 40 two & three-liter bottles per bag (\$2), and 100 one-liter, 16oz., & 20 oz. bottles per bag (\$5).

Directions:

Coming from town dump: Take a right on Boston Road. At lights with Breckwood on left and Harding on right, (You'll see a church/school on your left), take Bay St. which is between Boston Rd. and Harding St.

Once you cross Roosevelt Ave., (You'll see a Springfield high school on your left), the redemption center is about a half mile up on your right on Bay Street. It is just past Roy's Towing and it *may* have a big yellow or big white truck in front.

Bring everything inside and they will give you the cash. Remember to ask for a box of bags or for more glass boxes if we are getting low.

The cash should go in an envelope, labeled "Redeemable" with: Scout Name, Date, and Amount collected and given to the troop treasurer Mrs. Douglass at the next troop meeting. She will deposit 80% of the funds into your scout account.
